Year 12 Option Blocks for September 2017 (v4)

The grid below shows the most likely blocking arrangement for Year 12 courses starting in September 2017. **There is no guarantee that this will be the final arrangement** since we may have to adapt to enable groups to run, or to better suit the majority of our students' needs. Using information provided to us by our current Year 11 students, we have tried to get subject groups that should fit as many possible combinations with all but a few students able to choose 3 out of their first 4 initial preferences.

It is important to realise that **courses will only run if there is sufficient uptake**. This will depend on viability. In addition, if courses are oversubscribed, the Subject Team Leader will make a judgement on who will be accepted onto the course based on; 1.) this form, 2.) performance at KS4 and 3.) future aspirations.

Guidance Notes:

1) The general entry requirement to Caldew School Sixth Form is 5 A*-C grades or equivalent at GCSE in total (for example, 4s or above in English Language and Maths can be part of this).

2) If you want to study any of the subjects listed below, you need to achieve at least a B grade in the subject at GCSE:

- Biology (at least a B grade in the exams element)
- Chemistry (at least a B grade in the exams element)
- Computing
- History (or an equivalent if not studied at GCSE)
- Music
- Physics (at least a B grade in the exams element)

3) If you want to study Chemistry or Physics, you also need to study a Maths course at AS or A level. You can choose Core Maths from Block E if you don't choose Maths.

4) To study a Maths course, you need to achieve the following Maths grades:

- For AS/A level Maths A minimum of GCSE grade 6 (we will consider a high grade 5 in exceptional circumstances)
- For Further Maths A minimum of GCSE grade 7
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- For Core Maths A minimum of GCSE grade 4

5) Block E – EPQ (Extended Project Qualification), Core Maths and Further Maths - is there for you to indicate that you want to consider adding the EPQ to your subjects. Your GCSE results will determine how many AS courses you follow in Year 12. Some students will study 3 AS courses and the EPQ whilst most students will study 4 AS courses with the option to take the EPQ as well.
