Key Stage 4

The way GCSE grades are awarded was changed for 2016/17. The numbers 9 (highest) to 1 (lowest) are not used. A grade 4 is comparable to an old grade C and grade 7 to an old grade A.

In 2018 the EBacc attainment measure has changed from the percentage of pupil's achieving the EBacc at grade 5 or above to the EBacc average point score. This shows the pupil's point scores across the five pillars of EBacc.
