Year 12 Option Blocks for September 2020

The grid below shows the most likely blocking arrangement for Year 12 courses starting in September 2020. **There is no guarantee that this will be the final arrangement** since we may have to adapt the blocks to enable groups to run, or to better suit the majority of our students' needs. However, we have used the information provided to us by you to try and get subject groups that should fit as many possible combinations with all students able to choose 2 out of their first 3 initial preferences.

It is important to realise that **courses will only run if there is sufficient uptake**. In addition, if courses are oversubscribed, the Head of Department will make a judgement on who will be accepted onto the course based on; 1.) this form, 2.) performance at KS4 and, 3.) future aspirations.

In **addition** to choosing three subjects from the below columns, students need to choose either Core Maths or EPQ. Core Maths and the EPQ run in Year 12, allowing students to then concentrate on their three main A Level courses in Year 13. Please refer to the guidance notes overleaf for those subjects that require you to follow a maths course and the required GCSE grade. (bullet points 3 and 4 of the entry requirements)

Guidance Notes:

Step 1: Show your choices by numbering the box next to the subjects you would like to study (1 the most important, 3 not as important). **You must choose at least 3 subjects and they must be in different option blocks.** (In exceptional circumstances and after GCSE results are available it may be possible for a student to take four subjects from different columns. If students want to follow the Further Maths course they also must pick Maths from either Block A or Block D)

Step 2: Choose one of the subjects from the additional table. Tick the small box beside the subject you want to study.

Step 3: If you wish, use the space below to comment on any of the above.

Entry requirements

1) The general entry requirement to Caldew School Sixth Form is five 9-4 grades or equivalent at GCSE in total.

2) If you want to study any of the subjects listed below, you need to achieve at least a grade 5 in the subject at GCSE:

- Biology
- Chemistry
- English Literature
- History (or an equivalent if not studied at GCSE)
- Music
- Physics

If you study a GCSE Combined Science course rather than triple, you need to achieve at least a grade 5 in the subject you want to study at A level.

3) If you want to study Computer Science, Chemistry or Physics, you also need to study a Maths course at AS or A level. You can choose **Core Maths** if you don't choose Maths.

4) To study a Maths course, you need to achieve the following Maths grades:

- For AS/A level Maths A minimum of GCSE grade 6 (we will consider a high grade 5 in exceptional circumstances)
- For Further Maths A minimum of GCSE grade 7 (and choose Maths A Level)
- For Core Maths A minimum of GCSE grade 4
