KS3 Curriculum Information

The Religion, Philosophy and Ethics Key Stage 3 learning journey invites students to explore, think deeply and examine religion, philosophical ideas and ethical issues.

The learning journey begins in Year 7 with students exploring what religion is, ultimate questions and world religions and world views.

In Year 8 students investigate how people such as Doctor Martin Luther King Junior and Malala Yousafzai put their beliefs into action, the life of Jesus and his global impact today and how a Prince named Siddhartha learnt about the existence of suffering then founded Buddhism.

The Religion, Philosophy and ethics Key Stage 3 learning journey is completed in Year 9 in which students are challenged to critically evaluate philosophical ideas and ethical issues such as whether there is a soul and medical ethics.

Religion, Philosophy and Ethics is an incredibly successful subject at Caldew School, students can choose to continue their learning journey by studying the Religion, Philosophy and Ethics GCSE. The Religion, Philosophy and Ethics GCSE results are outstanding.
