Provide regular information on student attendance.
<b>Classwork and Homework</b>	support and encourage learning at home; ensure all deadlines are met.	take responsibility for my own learning; work hard and complete all tasks set to the best of my ability, meeting all deadlines. Tell a teacher if I am worried or concerned about any aspect of my learning.	provide quality learning experiences with a broad and balanced curriculum; teach effective lessons and prepare appropriate work that is challenging and regularly assessed.
<b>Extra-curricular Activities</b>	encourage our child's learning through extra-curricular activities and independent learning.	strive to attain excellence in all its forms through full participation in the academic, sporting and extra-curricular activities of the school.	provide extra-curricular activities to develop the broader skills that assist with personal, social, physical and cultural development of students.

<b>Behaviour for Learning</b>	encourage our child to have a positive attitude to learning and high standards of behaviour at all times.	take responsibility for my behaviour and learning. Set the highest standards for younger students to follow in school and when travelling to and from school. Respect people in the wider surrounding community.	encourage all members of Caldew School community to value the qualities of others and in turn to feel valued themselves; encourage high expectations and reward high standards of behaviour at all times.
<b>Pastoral Care</b>	inform the school if there are any circumstances likely to affect our child's learning; inform the school of any changes to emergency contact numbers.	let an adult know if I have any concerns or worries affecting my work or well-being, or that of others.	listen to and respond constructively to students' and parents' concerns.
