



Caldew School Summer School: 9th – 13th August 2021

We delivered a Summer School programme to support transition from Year 6 to Year 7, with a blend of academic and enrichment activities, meeting the conditions of the DfE Summer School Programme funding.

Programme Content:

We used the Summer School Programme Funding to run PET-Xi's Epic Summer which included teaching and learning of Maths and English along with daily enrichment activities. We provided lunches for learners on site to support the programme working alongside PET-Xi teams. Each PET-Xi team comprised a Motivational Lead Trainer, a Maths Expert and an English Expert (subject specialists), and a Support Trainer, and this team works with a group of learners for the whole week. PET-Xi insisted upon high staffing ratios especially for those learners who are new to school or need that bit of extra support.

We were asked to select content from menus designed by PET-Xi's Head of Curriculum to target key areas of the National Curriculum in Maths and English. Doing it this way ensures that our Head of Maths and the Head of English are selecting content and skills specific to our learner requirements and can ensure that activities are successfully integrated into the curriculum. This provided targeted content and resources for 1 ½ hrs of Maths and 1 ½ hrs of English teaching and learning each day, and every session started and ended with a mini confidence test. Enrichment activities included tower-building contests, football, arts and crafts, dodgeball and Aeroplane Olympics.
