Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing to update you on the plans for students returning to school and how the testing programme will be organised.

Year 8 students will return to school once they have had a COVID-19 test. These tests will take place on the afternoon of Thursday 11 March and students will need to make their own way to school. Students should attend school for their test according to the schedule below.

If students are unsure of their class code, they can find this information on Firefly.

Once tested students will wait for their result and if their test is negative they will then be able to go to their classroom. Students will be able to get school buses home.

If the test comes back positive your child will be kept away from other children, we will phone you to explain what happens next and you will need to come and collect your child from school.

If you choose for your child not to be tested, then they should return to school at 8.30am on Friday 12 March.

Online learning will continue for Year 8 until they return to school.

In line with the new national guidance students will have to wear face coverings in lessons as well as in all other areas of the building. If your child is medically exempt, you need to provide a letter to confirm this and this must be brought to school when students arrive on Thursday.

When your child arrives at school they should go to the Sports Hall car park and they will be directed to the testing centre which is in the Sports Hall.

If your child is unable to attend at the time given above, we do have some appointments for tests after school. Please email us at student.testing@caldew.cumbria.sch.uk and we will do our best to arrange a time that you can make.

Year 8 students will then be tested again twice 3-5 days apart and this means that students will be retested on:

- Tuesday 16 March
- Monday 22 March

Students will be taken out of lessons on these days for their test. After these tests have happened parents will be given test kits so that you can test your child at home. We do understand that some parents and carers may find this daunting and so we will have testing facilities available at school so

that we can test your child for you. We will provide you with more details about this once students have returned to school.

Other year groups are being phased back into school across the week so that all students can be tested before they return to classrooms. The schedule for this is below

On school buses it is essential that students sit within their year group bubbles and wear face masks throughout the journey. They should stay 2m apart from others whenever this is possible, including at bus stops. Please discuss the importance of this with your child.

I have attached a letter giving more details about the COVID-19 Lateral Flow test, the privacy notice and consent form. We cannot test students unless we receive the consent form. If you want to have your child tested please complete the attached form and return to student.testing@caldew.cumbria.sch.uk by 9am Thursday 4 March.

If you do not want to give consent for your child to have a COVID-19 Lateral Flow test, please can you also let us know by emailing the above email address.

We are really looking forward to getting our students back to school but I do know that some of you will be anxious about their return. I would like to take this opportunity to reassure you that we will continue to have robust protective measures in place to protect the whole school community. I will write to you again next week with details of these protective measures.
