THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH'S AWARD

After the disruption of the pandemic, we plan to restart the bronze Duke of Edinburgh's award at Caldew School.

The Duke of Edinburgh's Award is a voluntary, non-competitive programme of practical, cultural and adventurous activities, designed to support the personal and social development of young people. It offers an individual challenge and encourages young people to undertake exciting, constructive, challenging and enjoyable things in their free time. The Award is widely recognised in further education and by employers.

There are four sections to the Award. Participants should complete a minimum of an hour a week over 3 months on each of the first three sections (Volunteering, Physical and Skills), with an additional 3 months to be spent on one of the sections. Students are expected to make their own arrangements for these sections, although this could involve participation in an existing club either at school or elsewhere. In every case, students are expected to keep a record of their activity and an unrelated qualified adult will be expected to act as a supervisor, completing a brief assessment to confirm participation. The fourth section is the expedition. This is a two-day walking and one-night camping journey which is arranged by the school. Full training will be given by members of staff who have experience leading expeditions in the UK and who hold nationally recognised qualifications. Regardless of a students' previous experience, preparation is compulsory which includes a practice expedition.

Provisional dates for this year's bronze award expeditions are:

- 26th March 2022 Practice Expedition, Caldbeck, Saturday 9am-5pm
- 7th 8th May 2022 Qualifying Expedition, Ullswater, 9am Saturday 4pm Sunday

To apply for a place, your child will need to complete the attached application form, this should be submitted to Mr Sharpe by Tuesday 1st February 2022. For payment of the enrolment fee of £45, please login to Ipayimpact and select the following; **Child's Account > Add trip to basket.** If you wish to pay by cheque, please make it payable to 'Caldew School' and return with the application form.

The fee includes £33 for enrolment and a welcome pack which goes to Cumbria Outdoors. The remainder is a contribution towards expedition equipment, emergency transport and first aid provision. If a student withdraws from the award, the fee is non-refundable. There will be an additional charge for use of the expedition campsite due at the time of the expedition (approximately £10 per night).

All participants get access to a range of discounts from online shops and the welcome pack includes a Reward Card which entitles the holder to an extra 10% off products at Go Outdoors and an extra 15% off products at Blacks, Millets, Ultimate Outdoors and Tiso.
